## 2. Skits on identified subjects

The Skits segment allowed participants to present short, theatrical performances based on a given theme or prompt based on BIS standards. This segment aimed to enhance their acting skills, teamwork, and ability to convey messages through performance.

- Feedback: The skits were noted for their originality and humor. Some skits could benefit from tighter scripts and more rehearsals.

### 3. Standards Parliament

Description:

The Parliament segment was a mock debate where participants engaged in discussions on BIS standards. This segment was designed to test their debating skills, critical thinking, and ability to argue logically.

Key Highlights:

- Number of Teams: 10
- Topics Debated: BIS STANDARDS
- Judges: Dr Geetha /Associate professor/English/Sri Sairam Engineering College

- Feedback: The debates were lively and well-informed. Participants were encouraged to work on their rebuttal strategies and ensure balanced arguments.
